

2020 BOARD NOMINATIONS

Our club's process for nominating club board officers and conducting the election commences in October (next meeting). Active club members can nominating club members for office at the October meeting either in person or by proxy nomination which can be given to any existing officer prior to the meeting.

All candidates will be published in the newsletter prior to the November meeting. Voting will be held at the November meeting (check the newsletter for the date). Mail-in ballots will be made available to those members who have voting rights but cannot attend the meeting (see the club secretary for a proxy ballot). Those ballots, returned by mail before the November meeting, will be counted as if those persons were present at the meeting. A majority vote is required to win the election.

Elected officers serve for one year commencing on January 1st following the election. Their term ends on December 31st following the election.

Supporting Personnel will be appointed by the elected officers and confirmed by a simple majority vote of those members present and voting during a regular meeting: i.e. Newsletter Editor, Contest Director, etc.

HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

- Obey all AMA and Club Safety Rules.
- In case of fire at the field, call 911 immediately. If fire crews appear, either by truck and/or by air, immediately cease flying and ground your aircraft. All emergency responders, fire and law enforcement, are given priority to combat any and all threats that endanger life, property and the safety of individuals. Please do your best to assist and not be part of the problem.



- As of January 1, 2019 all members are required to have an ABC Fire Extinguisher
 at the field when they fly located in the pit area. Fly safe and be safe. Bring a First
 Aid Kit as added protection.
- Our field is in an area populated by wildlife including snakes. Please be aware of this danger and act accordingly when walking in the brush.
- Please pickup your trash before leaving the field and dispose of it in trash containers or
 if needed take it home with you.
- Fly with a buddy! Sometimes having an extra set of hands and eyes are helpful!
